

Declaration Requirements	B.A. Minor Anthropology
Declare	By the last day of the quarter, two quarters before degree conferral.
1. Apply	Apply in Axxess for the B.A. Minor in Anthropology.
2. Plan	Meet with the Undergraduate Student Services Officer or Peer Advisor to prepare the Minor Form
3. File	Submit the forms to the Undergraduate Student Services Officer and request Faculty Advisor assignment.
4. Advise	Meet with your Faculty Advisor to approve the Major Form – quarterly meetings recommended.
Degree Requirements	B.A. Minor Anthropology
Total Units (Must be coherent program of study; approval from Anthropology Faculty Advisor required)	30 units, pass with a minimum GPA of 2.0. A minimum of 15 units must be ANTHRO courses numbered 100 or above.
Required Anthropology Courses Of the 30 units, a minimum of 10 units must be taken from the chosen ANTHRO emphasis with a minimum letter grade of 'C'; faculty advisor approval required.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. For the Culture and Society emphasis, most courses are numbered ANTHRO 120 through ANTHRO 150. 2. For the Ecology, Environment, and Evolution emphasis, most courses are numbered ANTHRO 160 through ANTHRO 178. 3. For the Medical Anthropology emphasis, most courses are numbered ANTHRO 179 through ANTHRO 185. <p><i>Note:</i> Department courses may fulfill the requirements for more than one emphasis.</p>

Satisfactory/No Grade Credit	No more than 10 units may be taken for a satisfactory/no credit grade (5 ANTHRO units, 5 Related or Transfer units).
Directed Individual Study	No more than 5 units may count towards the minor.
Undergraduates with Field Research Grants	Students who receive Anthropology grants are required to enroll in ANTHRO 93. Pre-field Research Seminar and ANTHRO 94. Post-field Research Seminar. Students are encouraged to take ANTHRO 92. UG Research Proposal Writing Workshop in the Fall and Winter quarters before submitting a grant application/research proposal. Students who receive other research grant must consult the granting agency for enrollment requirements. Students whose research interests are better served by another course may petition for a requirements substitution with different (pre) field course supported by the advisor and approved by petition to the Undergraduate Committee.
Advising Milestones	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. In the quarter in which the minor is declared, students must meet with their assigned faculty advisor and create a rigorous course of study, which includes a chosen emphasis. 2. Any revisions to the initial minor form must be approved by the faculty advisor. The signed form is placed in the student's file. 3. Students must submit an updated minor form to the Undergraduate Student Services Specialist in the quarter before graduating.
